Aging:	Aged 20 months in mostly American and some French oak.

	Vivid ruby-red. Oak-spiced cherry and candied rose aromas are complemented by suggestions of mocha, smoked meat and pipe tobacco. Chewy and focused on the palate, offering bitter cherry, vanilla and dark chocolate flavors that become more energetic with aeration. Finishes spicy and quite long,
