




RIOJA BORDÓN ROYAL RED

Region:	DOC Rioja
Varietal:	Red
Winemaker:	Ruben Provedo
Grape Varieties:	Tempranillo (80%), Garnacha (20%)
Tasting Notes:	75% percent of the grapes are fermented by the traditional "destemmed" method and 25% by carbonic maceration which allows the fruit of the grape to shine through. Purple-blue in color with ruby tones. Elegant on the nose with fruity aromas, soft wood and spice notes.
Aging:	Aged in American oak for six months and bottle-aged for two months.
