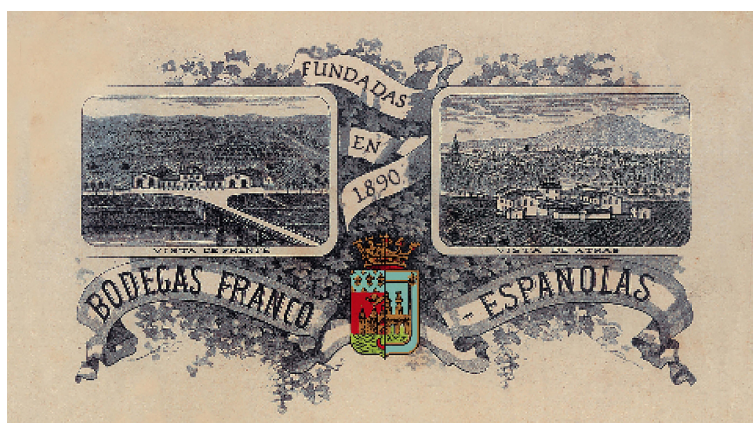
Tasting Notes: The blend of Tempranillo, Mazuelo and Graciano grapes in contact with the best Allier oak produces a harmonious, well-rounded and very attractive cherry-red wine with garnet hues. Well-defined aromas of ripe red forest fruit, spices, smoky toasted oak and a hint of coffee. Velvety, mature, smooth and well-rounded.

Enjoy with casseroles and stews. Excellent with grilled, barbecued and roast meats.

Aging: Aged 18 months in French oak.

Welcoming aromas of cola, oak and earthy plum are a touch tarry and fiery. On the palate, this shows moderate to good depth... Flavors of leafy, earthy berry and plum are lightly oaked and finish with spice notes attached to lingering berry and plum fruit. Drink through 2035. - M.S. 9/19
