There's a varied and juicy palette of flavors in this Ribera, from red fruit to spices and herbs. It fills the mouth with fruit, delineated by intense acidity that manages to counteract the ripeness. If you were looking for a wine for bacon burgers, you've found it.



Bodegas Valparaíso, located in Quintana del Pidio (Burgos) is also known as Ribera's Garden, situated on a mound overlooking the town and it's old buildings. Bodegas Valparaíso began on the 28th October 2000 it's journey in Ribera del Duero, one of the most attractive and thriving appellations in Spain. It boasts 70 Hectares of privately owned vineyard planted mostly with Tempranillo vines, also known locally as Tinta Fina or Tinta del País. The oldest vines were planted early in the 20th Century on bush vines, and the younger ones early in the 21st Century on trellis lines.
