**Vineyard** The vineyard with the longest tradition in our company. Our oldest wine from this vineyard dates back to 1947. The current terraces were created in 1986 and planted with our own Grüner Veltliner selection by Sepp Mantler sen. The name 'Spiegel' comes from 'spiegeln' (Latin 'spiculum') and means 'particularly large terraces with a good view in the centre of a slope'. Another etymological root could also be 'to reflect', i.e. to stand out positively from other vineyards.

**Vinification** 90% whole bunch pressing

10% crushed Stainless steel

**Age of Vines** 25 years (1987 and 2014)

**Tasting Notes** Spiegel is always an example of clearly

structured, powerful but straightforward Grüner Veltliner. Stylistically, this wine is the model for our winery. All Grüner Veltliner vines on our estate are traditionally selected
