

The label for Pelotón de la Muerte is the flag "The Doliente Hidalgo", is the banner that represented the insurgents call. "The Squadron of the Dead", that represents the flag of the insurgents used during Mexico's revolution to avenge Miguel Hidalgo.

The flag was overlaid on the mural that was painted by a native from Coyoacan, Juan O'Gorman in the Castle of Chapultepec.
