Vineyard Vineyards planted in the plateau of Beira Interior wine region

Grape Varieties

80% Tinta Roriz (Tempranillo)

10% Touriga Nacional 30% Jaen (Mancia)

Vinification Hand-picked. Reception with destemming

followed by immediate crushing.

Fermentation between 22-26 C for 7 days with smooth maceration in cement tanks, using the classic technique of the "delestage"

3-4 by fermentation.

Aging 12 month in French Oak

Tasting Notes

Very intense aroma, wild fruit and spices with notes of licorice in perfect balance with discrete hints of vanilla and toasted oak barrels. This is a fine structured wine firmness

on the finish.
