Tasting Notes Fruity aromas with very elegant yet discreet
minerality. Berries and spices, with a fresh,
fruity lasting finish. The soul of this wine lies
in the unique combination of the Touriga
Nacional and Tinta Roriz grape varieties,
from old vines planted in granite and schist
soils with quartz veins, in the Douro River's
hydrographical basin, at an average altitude
of 700 meters above sea level.

pastas and Mediterranean cuisine.
