Region Beira Interior Soil

Granite and Schist with Quartz veins

Elevation 725 Meters Alcohol 12.5%

Vineyard Various vineyards at an average of 700 meters above sea level

Grape Varieties 45% Síria

45% Fonte Cal 10% Godello

Vinification Hand picked grapes, are fully-destemmed, whole-cluster pressed, fermentation at 16–17°C using native yeasts during 20 days.

Aging 4 months in stainless steel vats

Tasting Notes

Mineral and citrus fruitiness, grapefruit, hints of nettle and white flowers, very fresh and light on the palate, revealing the altitude of the vineyards. The soul of this wine lies in the unique combination of the Síria and Fonte Cal native grape varieties, from old vines planted in granite and schist soils with quartz veins, in the Douro River's hydrographical basin, at an average altitude of 700 meters.

Excellent as an aperitif, with appetizers, grilled fish and shellfish and to share with friends!
