Vineyard Château Maris is in AOP Minervois La Livinière, Languedoc, nestled between the Mediterranean Sea, Pyrenees, and Black Mountains.

Grape Varieties Syrah, Grenache (15% max)

Vinification Fermented for 8 days in concrete and wood open fermenters at 23°C and maceration post at 28°C for 4 weeks. Lies battonage – marc crushing everyday for 2 weeks.

Aging 12 months in new French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes A bouquet of already complex aromas with hints of sautéed black cherries, blackcurrant, licorice, pepper, and cured meats. Dark purple color. Rich, full-bodied, yet elegant and seamless, with an impressive texture.
