**Vineyard** Dona Maria Estate / Dom Martinho /

**Grape Varieties** 40% Alicante Bouschet  
25% Touriga Nacional  
20% Syrah  
15% Cabernet Sauvignon

**Vinification** Grapes picked manually in 15Kg cases.  
The grapes are then destemmed, crushed  
and transferred into temperature-controlled  
(23°C–25°C) stainless steel tanks where  
they ferment for 10 days.

**Aging** 6 months in French oak barrels.

**Tasting Notes** Clear, bright violet color. Complex red  
berries, with notes of overripe plums. Rich  
red berry flavor with great persistence.  
Balanced and well-rounded with a good  
structure that will allow it to age well.
