Vinification The “Steinbock Selection Dr. Fischer” was born from the commitment of the Alto Adige vintner Martin Foradori Hofstätter. In March 2014, he took the opportunity to revive the traditional German estate “Weingut Dr. Fischer”. Only Grapes from exquisite vineyards form the basis of the “Selection Dr. Fischer”. This “Spätburgunder” or better known as Pinot Noir, stands out with its fresh, vibrant bouquet of berry notes. On the palate it is harmonious, well structured and is distinguished by its varietal correctness. Sourced from a premium selection of lots in Baden, this wine is an exceptional value to introduce new and old lovers of Pinot Noir to a historic region through a new lens.

Age of Vines 5–35 years

Tasting Notes Ripe blackberry fruit on the nose, with hints of black pepper, cloves and subtle vanilla. Juicy and spicy on the tongue. A pleasantly intense aroma of dark cherries and plums.
